■ Adobe Premiere Pro Beginner Project – My Mini Video Journal

- **Objective:** Learn the basics of video editing in Adobe Premiere Pro using only simple tools like import, trim, title, and export without effects or transitions.
- **Project Description:** Students will create a 30–60 second video journal showing a short theme such as 'My Favorite Memory,' 'My School Day,' or 'My Pet.' The video should include a title at the start and end, arranged clips or photos, and clear audio no effects or transitions.

■ Step-by-Step Instructions:

- 1. Create a New Project: Open Adobe Premiere $Pro \rightarrow click New Project \rightarrow name it 'My Mini Video Journal.'$
- 2. Import Files: Import 3-4 short clips or photos from your folder.
- 3. Arrange in Timeline: Drag clips onto the timeline in the correct order.
- 4. **Trim Clips:** Use Selection (V) and Razor (C) tools to shorten or cut clips. Keep the total length under 1 minute.
- 5. **Add Titles:** Add opening and ending text using Graphics \rightarrow New Layer \rightarrow Text.
- 6. Adjust Audio: Ensure sound levels are balanced and not too loud.
- 7. Preview: Watch your full video and check the sequence.
- 8. **Export:** File \rightarrow Export \rightarrow Media \rightarrow Format: H.264 (.mp4) \rightarrow Preset: Match Source High Bitrate \rightarrow Save as 'My_Video_Journal.mp4'.
