The viewpoint of the camera can make or break a photo

DEPTH OFFIELD

Depth of field creates emphasis on the subject

DISTANCE

Use distance to bring out detail or emphasize scale






COLOURS & LIGHTING

WARM Colours give off a HAPPY mood

COOL Colours give off a SAD mood

Posed photos look great!
But a photo of something as it happens is more interesting!

Capturing a moment without the subject noticing the camera at the time allows you to capture their most natural emotions and expressions!

SYMMETRY

Its all about finding the right balance in the view!

The position of the subject in relation to other objects in frame

Finding patterns and interesting shapes in a shot



















Use negetive space to balance your photos!

One far/SMALL








SEPERATION

Keeping subjects from merging with objects in the background

A "merger" occurs when something in the background seems to "merge" out of or into your subject.

This happens when you are so focused on your subject you do not pay attention to the background.

You should always be mindful of other objects in the frame that may seem to "merge" with the subject.



EDGERS 10 I = MERGERS SUBJECT MERGERS

SUBJECT MERGERS

Avoid viewpoints where the subject overlaps with an object in the background!





TONE MERGERS

Avoid colours in the background that are similar or conflict with the subject!





EDGE MERGERS

Cutting off a part of a subjects head, legs, arms, knees etc. from the frame look awkward!
