■ Adobe Premiere Pro Beginner Project – Lift, Extract, Crop & PIP

- **Objective:** Learn basic timeline editing using Lift, Extract, Cropping with In/Out points, and Picture-in-Picture (PIP). All editing must be done without effects only timeline and Program Panel tools.
- Project Description: Create a 45–60 second video titled 'My Favorite Place'. Combine 3–4 short clips or images and demonstrate how to lift and extract unwanted parts, crop by setting In/Out points, zoom/reposition clips manually in the Program Panel, and create a simple Picture-in-Picture layout.

■ Step-by-Step Instructions:

- 1. Create a New Project: Open Adobe Premiere $Pro \rightarrow New Project \rightarrow Name$ it 'My Favorite Place'.
- 2. **Import Media:** Import 3–4 video clips or photos of your favorite place (e.g., park, school, home).
- 3. Arrange in Timeline: Drag clips into Video Track 1 in sequence and review the flow.
- 4. Crop Using In/Out Points: Move Playhead \rightarrow Press I to mark In, O to mark Out \rightarrow Drag selected part from Source Monitor to Timeline to remove unwanted start/end portions.
- 5. **Use Lift and Extract Tools:** Mark a section on the timeline with I and $O \rightarrow Use$ Lift (;) to remove and leave gap, Extract (') to remove and close gap automatically.
- 6. **Zoom and Reposition in Program Panel:** Double-click a clip in Program Panel \rightarrow Drag corners to zoom in/out \rightarrow Move inside frame to reposition the subject manually.
- 7. Create Picture-in-Picture (PIP): Place a clip or image on Video Track $2 \rightarrow$ Double-click in Program Panel \rightarrow Resize smaller and drag to one corner.
- 8. Add Simple Titles: Graphics \rightarrow New Layer \rightarrow Text \rightarrow Add opening ('My Favorite Place') and closing ('Created by [Your Name]') titles.
- 9. **Preview and Export:** Review full timeline \rightarrow File \rightarrow Export \rightarrow Media \rightarrow Format: H.264 (.mp4) \rightarrow Preset: Match Source High Bitrate \rightarrow Save as 'My Favorite Place.mp4'.
